

Nine ALMOs Named ‘Top 50 Landlords’

Arm’s Length Management Organisations feature heavily in list of England’s best social housing landlords

The National Federation of ALMOs (NFA) is celebrating after nine of its 47 members (almost a fifth of all ALMOs) were named ‘Top 50 Landlords’ by industry magazine 24housing.

The ALMO sector was well represented in the list which featured social and affordable housing providers from across England. North West ALMO Stockport Homes narrowly missed out on the number one spot which went to New Charter Housing Trust Group, but celebrated retaining second place for two years running.

Also making the Top 50 were Wolverhampton Homes (12), Berneslai Homes (16), Barnet Homes (19), Nottingham City Homes (22), Solihull Community Housing (33), Newark and Sherwood Homes (34), Northwards Housing (35), The Gateshead Housing Company (43), and Kirklees Neighbourhood Housing (44).

NFA Chair, Sue Roberts, said: “Once again ALMOs across the country both large and small have featured very strongly in the Top 50. I would like to congratulate all our members who made the list. I know firsthand what a difference ALMOs make in our communities and to see so many being included alongside some of the largest housing associations is a fantastic achievement.”

The list was compiled by industry magazine 24housing to try and find the nation’s top landlords and to recognise best practice in the sector.
