

## **Press release - New Chair of the Homes for Haringey Board**

Aman Dalvi, OBE has been selected for appointment as Chair of the Board of Homes for Haringey. He will take up the role from 19 September following his formal appointment at a Board meeting on 25 July. He brings almost thirty years' housing sector experience to the role – all of it London based. His experience spans local authorities, housing associations, trade and third sector bodies and ALMOs. He has held the role of Chair for a number of housing associations including Anchor, the largest social provider of housing for the elderly.

Aman has an MSc in Public Sector Management and is a Member of the Chartered Institute of Housing. He was awarded an OBE in 2000 for Services for Housing.

Tracie Evans, Deputy Chief Executive of Haringey Council and a member of the panel recruiting the Chair said: "The choice of Aman for the role of Chair was unanimous. His experience and understanding of the housing sector is second to none. His commitment to the delivery of excellent services to residents chimes with the objectives of the Board. I'm delighted to welcome Aman to Homes for Haringey and look forward to working with him in what is a challenging time."

Aman Dalvi said: "This is a very challenging time for social housing providers who have to deliver more but with fewer resources. I look forward to working with the Board, Haringey Council and the staff of Homes for Haringey in meeting these challenges. I believe in delivering high quality, value for money services to residents, and this will be one of my top priorities."

Aman will succeed Tom McGregor in September 2017. Tom has held the role of interim Chair since September 2016 and has kept the Board focussed on leading the organisation effectively.
